Jackson has racing in the blood. His father Glenn is a multi-State and National Champion in motocross, dirt track and speedway, international coach and world championship winning race team manager.

Keen to make his own mark, Jackson made a bold move away from the dirt to road racing as a 9-year-old and has not looked back since.

Jackson's riding style and off-track charm has captured the attention of many in the road racing community, reminiscent of racing stars before him. Jackson is charismatic and is incredible public speaker who has appeared on stage at the Australian Motorcycle GP for an interview, has been interviewed on Live TV, youth local radio, and interviewed for his local newspaper numerous times.

Jackson's social media is built on his input and monitored by his parents. The pages portray an honesty and journey story that is engaging to his supporters.



THE HISTORY

At 9 years of age, Jackson was issued an age exemption to compete in his debut year on the FIM Mini GP Australia circuit. Learning, developing, and racing against 14 year olds, Jackson completed the 2022 season with race finishes in the top five - etching closer to the podium.

In 2023, at 10 years of age Jackson earned numerous PB's on the Ohvale 160cc in the FIM Mini GP Australia World Series, smashing his lap times from 2022. Jackson achieved consistent top five race finishes and set multiple lap times and records along the way. With all but one of the top five racers moving into the 190cc class in 2024, Jackson elected to not contest the series in 2024.

2023 saw a deep faith and support of his development with the introduction of 'big-bike racing'. On a Scriven's Honda custom RS85cc, in a Moto3 chassis, Jackson raced the two-stroke against some of Australia's rising stars, setting lap times at Broadford Motorcycle circuit while chipping away at the long-held Joel Kelso lap record. Jackson also crept up on the top five in the Ohvale Series, with a podium along the way.

In 2024, Jackson has inched closer to setting a new lap record at Mount Gambier in the GP85 class and has most recently set both qualifying and race lap records at 'The Bend', beating his nearest junior competitors by significant margins. Jackson has also matched Joel Kelso's lap record at Broadford, just 0.034 shy of setting the new junior GP85cc record.

Jackson has competed in 6 of the 7 rounds of the Spanish MIR Finetwork Texking Series, an International world series, on board his Moto5 and managed well with exposure to new circuits and conditions. Jackson has secured several top ten results and is poised to move to Promo3, a 300cc machine in similar style to the Australian R3 Cup.

THE RACING

Small stature (perfect for GP racing!) and age both place limitations on Jackson in terms of Australian-based racing opportunities. Based on this, Jackson will not be able to compete in the Oceania Junior Cup, a natural pathway for developing racers in Australia. He will need to ensure access to deep fields of high-quality racers, which at this time, is based overseas.

2023 saw a deep faith and support of his development with the introduction of 'big-bike racing'. On a Scriven's Honda custom RS85cc, in a Moto3 chassis, Jackson raced the two-stroke against some of Australia's rising stars, setting lap times at Broadford Motorcycle circuit while chipping away at the long-held Joel Kelso lap record. 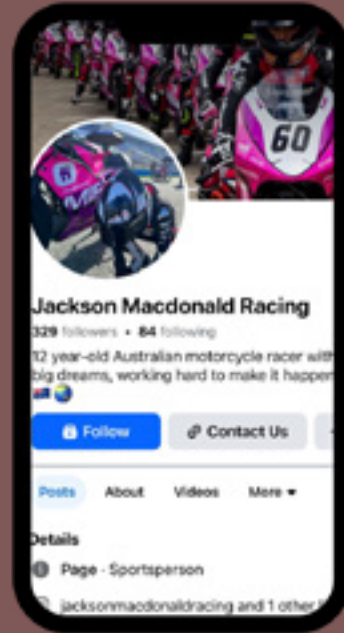
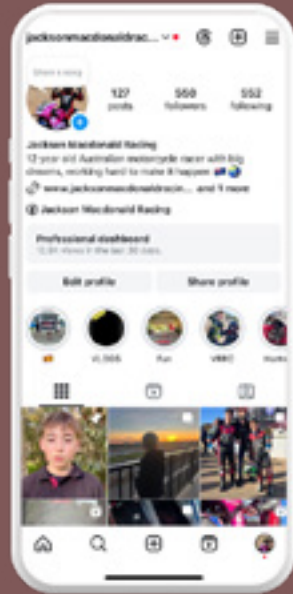
